- 13. Welcome to Princetown Signs Council to discuss and agree on whether to replace them, and how this could be funded. The cost of replacing the signs has been quoted by DCC Highways as £241 ex vat. It was suggested at the November meeting that Council could purchase the signs, but also approach local businesses asking them to make a donation to cover some of the cost (as happened in Hexworthy to replace the noticeboard).

- 14. Play Park Council to discuss, agree actions and expenditure to make repairs to the Play Park as identified in the Annual Inspection 2023. Inspection for 2024 has been scheduled by RoSPA, and is likely to take place in early March. Cllr Williams has identified the following items are required to make the necessary repairs to the play park. Clerk obtaining quotes for consideration at the meeting.
