Speedwatch Report

We were informed by Devon and Cornwall Police that it was once again safe to re-start Speeddwatch and they would very much like us to do so. Our first session was at the beginning of this month and we have now held four sessions.

Whilst out we have been witness to some very poor driving plus the occasional high speed driver. The majority of drivers are either keeping to the limit or not too high above. We seem to be averaging about 10 drivers per session which equates to about 15%, similar to last year.

I have obtained the details of animal deaths from Karla and they can be seen listed below. Still far too many but less than last year. This is partly due to the reduction of traffic during lockdown so clear to see a lot more has to be done. We have seen a rise in Police activity lately and I have been told that this will continue. The message is from them that if you continue to break the law you will be caught.

What is perhaps more worrying are the number of occasions where dogs are seen to be the cause of attacks on sheep. I have spoken to Inspector Sloman about this and he is also very concerned. He assures me they are doing their best to deal with this situation. One thing to consider is this, no-one wants to be the one to confront a dog owner whose dog is off the lead to tell them the rules but might it be a bit easier if we had a leaflet that certain people could carry which actually states what the situation is regarding dogs. I know that if you try to tell someone, they either do not believe you or think it's okay as there dog has never done such a thing in the past. The law needs to be very clear and the leaflet could state it applies to all dogs. I am going to look up the exact wording of this to see exactly what it does say. Is it a recommendation or a fact that has to be obeyed. I do not want time taken up at our meeting about this but would be interested to know what other councillors think about this. Just to be clear I am not talking about us producing this leaflet or paying for it I just want to know what support there might be.
