Thank you for your support of the Princetown Food Hub. As I am sure you are aware, it now supports 17 households - equating to 57 individuals - in the village. We are delighted to be moving into a unit in Duchy Square on 20th April, after our temporary accommodation in the old chapel building in Tor Royal Lane.

Please find enclosed with this cover note an application for a further grant from the Parish Council. The previous grant (very gratefully received) has been put towards the rent of the Duchy Square unit, enabling us to move in next month, as already mentioned. The current application, for £210, is for the purchase of enough food to keep the Food Hub stocked with a balance of fresh, dried and tinned food for several months. Any help that the Parish Council might be able to offer would be very much appreciated.
