From the above you can see that 39 drivers were not sent a letter. When identifying a vehicle that is speeding, we have to list a number of factors. Most importantly we list the speed, then we list the number plate, make, model, colour, and time. Speed and time are easy but the rest relies on our ability to look and memorise data which then has to be entered onto a log sheet. We need at least two but preferably three items of detail that match the DVLA computer or they have to be discarded. Just having the number plate it not enough. So 39 entries were not correct but this does not mean we were wrong as there are a number of reasons for the data not matching.

- a) Car might have been resprayed
- b) Number plates might be stolen or cloned and so on.

It tells us that 270 drivers got their first letters and 7 their second. This year so far there have been no 3<sup>rd</sup> letters sent. Finally 22 were reported to swan, this means further investigations are needed. This will include the three above who were not showing any tax and those considered going so fast that the police want to visit in person. It might also mean the vehicle is flagged on the system as wanted in connection to another crime or even one known to be flagged for county lines offences. Just to say when a car is coming towards you at 50 plus mile per hour you have very little time to get all the data.
