Princetown CCTV

I am pleased to say we have not had any need to use this system during the last month. I accessed the system yesterday (22/10/2021) to ensure it is working correctly. This is something myself, and Councillor Worth do on a regular basis. When we do this, we enter it into a log we both keep showing times and dates of access.

We have had a couple of occasions where the village has suffered from loss of electrical power which has caused the system to trip out. If not checked it remains in a state of inactivity. The system then has to be accessed in the Visitor Centre to be reset. To ensure this does not happen it is recommended we purchase a Uninterrupted Power Supply. This is effectively a battery which ensures that if the mains power fails this acts as a backup to ensure no loss of power to the system. I have been looking at them and it would seem that one would cost less than £150 but I was not able to confidently identify the right one for us, perhaps Councillor Worth can help with this. I propose that the council agree to this purchase especially when we consider the Winter snow is just around the corner.
